What's Happening?

Where: A4500/Weedon Road/Upton Valley Way North

What: Works will take place on the road that runs between Berrywood Road at the north and A4500 at the south to complete and connect this section of the road with the main network. Works will include; construction of the remaining carriageway to link to a road and various other works to ensure the road is up to standard for use.

When:

Works taking place between Monday 10 February 2025 – Spring 2025

Traffic Management:

The main works will not affect road users and are being completed off-network

Lane closures will be in place on A4500 for 3-4 weeks during March/April. We will send out further information about this.

Working Hours:

Works will be undertaken mainly during the daytime with some night time works.

Emergency Vehicles:

Access as normal.

Pedestrians and Cyclists:

No pedestrian access to this section of road will be allowed. A section of right of Way KP16 will also be closed. A safe diversion route will be in place. Please follow onsite signage.

Public Transport:

Unaffected for the majority of the works.
